The paper said the movie was a "blistering comic book escapade" that will be "a stratospheric hit". Mr Craig told reporters: "It is just a real honour to be part of it." Director Sam Mendes said: "I just wanted to make a film that I would like to see....I just wanted to channel my inner 13-year-old boy." The film is sure to add to the \$5.1 billion grossed at the worldwide box office by the previous 22 films in the franchise.
