when ms sitienei first tried to enroll at the school the head teacher david kinyanjui did not think it was a good idea now he is very happy that gogo is at the school mr kinyanjui said gogo is a "blessing and a motivator" he added "i'm very proud of her she is loved by every pupil they all want to learn and play with her" he also said "she is doing well considering her age it can say it have seen a big difference in this school since she came" gogo had a message for children everywhere saying "it want to say to the children of the world especially girls that education will be your wealth" she added "with education you can be whatever you want - a doctor lawyer or a pilot"
