The luxury carmaker will invest \$1.2 billion on the new vehicle. Porsche expects the new car, to be called the "Panamera", to sell somewhere in the region of 20,000 models a year, which would make it the company's best selling vehicle. The Stuttgart based factory is famed for the other three models that make up the Porsche line-up – the Boxster, the 911 sports car and the Cayenne SUV. Porsche's announcement confirms rumors that have been rife on the Internet that "some delectable new creation" would be emerging from the company.

The car is to be built solely by Porsche in Stuttgart and bear the "Made in Germany" hallmark of quality. Dr. Wendelin Wiedeking, the President and CEO of Porsche, said: "The Panamera is the right car ...as it has all the typical DNA characteristics of a genuine sports car. In terms of performance, design, and driving dynamics it meets Porsche's high standards in every respect.... we are making our customers an attractive offer in the top performance segment." The car will compete against other luxury family oriented models from Mercedes, Maserati, Aston Martin and Bentley. Porsche looks set to continue its uncanny knack of producing top quality automobiles for top profits.
