They said: "We would like to remind fans that the red carpet is being streamed live all over the world, so they can get the best views from the comfort of their own homes."

The scenes in central London were reminiscent of the hysteria surrounding the Beatles in the 1960s. The movie's director, Morgan Spurlock, told reporters: "This is probably the closest I'll get in my whole lifetime to seeing anything similar to Beatlemania....I just think it's remarkable." He added that the scenes were the same the world over: "It isn't just a British or an American phenomenon. Wherever they go they are chased by hordes of fans. We were in Mexico City and there were 5,000 people camping outside the hotel. This is such a massive global phenomenon and it's only growing."
