Another is that they are focused on their phone keyboard instead of their feet. A final reason is that their minds are somewhere else - they are not thinking about walking from A to B safely. The professor said over 6,000 people visited his hospital last year because of texting. He said the worst cases are head injuries. When a pedestrian is tossed into the air he/she has nothing to protect the head. The damage can be serious.
