Eleven models of car have the bags. The faulty airbags have been

linked to six deaths and over 100 injuries.

A US government spokesman said: "Today is a major step forward

for public safety. [We are] taking the proactive steps necessary to

ensure that defective [airbags] are replaced with safe ones as

quickly as possible." Takata's CEO said: "We are pleased to have

reached this agreement...which represents a clear path forward."

The recall will cost Takata and its customers up to \$5 billion. The

company will still make a profit this year.
