The data included information about people's financial situations, their debt, and their attitude towards money. They compared this data with surveys in which people answered questions about their personality and agreeableness. The researchers said agreeable people seemed to care less about money and so did not look after their money wisely. A researcher said being kind and trusting had "financial costs". She wanted to better understand, "why nice guys seem to finish last".
