Robert F. Smith, 56, graduated with an MBA with honors. He founded an investment company which manages over \$46 billion in assets. It made him a multi-billionaire. Mr Smith was the first African-American to sign the Giving Pledge. He promised to give at least half of his wealth away. A graduate who had his \$150,000 loan paid off said it would have an "immeasurable impact" on his life. He said: "Just imagine the weight lifted off your shoulders."
