He said: "This is my class, 2019, and my family is making a grant to eliminate their student loans." He added: "On behalf of the eight generations of my family who have been in this country, we're going to put a little fuel in your bus."

Robert F. Smith, 56, earned an MBA with honors from Columbia Business School. In 2000, he founded investment company Vista Equity Partners, which manages over \$46 billion in assets. Vista made him a multi-billionaire. Mr Smith was the first African-American to sign the Giving Pledge. People who sign this promise to give at least half of their wealth to different causes. A graduate who had his \$150,000 loan paid off said it would have an "immeasurable" impact" on his life. He said: "Just imagine the weight lifted off your shoulders when you have a clean slate coming out of college."
