This is because 92 per cent of the population live in towns and cities, and Tokyo is one of the most congested cities in the world. The president of ANA was excited about the project. He said: "ANA has 70 years of experience delivering safe and reliable flights....Being able to provide customers with the option to travel rapidly, and sustainably, from an international airport to a downtown location is very appealing."
